









Global opium poppy cultivation and production of opium, 1998-2024















Share of synthetic drugs reported seized in 2023




















New Psychoactive Substances: where the control system is working

Number of new psychoactive substances reported to have been on the market, 2010–2023




Toxicological findings in reported cases of direct <u>drug-related</u> mortality, 2023 or the most recent year for which data are available

· Shorter timeframe to complete tasks


· Less risk-averse: favour supply tactics

that prioritize transactions; more willing








While cannabis remains by far the world's most commonly used drug, accounting for: an estimated 42 per cent of drug use disorder cases worldwide (2021). ...

Global number of people who use drugs and prevalence of drug use, 2013, 2018 and 2023











Impact of Drug Use











Drug use strikes different people differently as different mediators interact, develop and combine in different ways, defining many pathways of impact








Criminal justice response

Percentage of reporting countries that criminalize specific <u>drug-related</u> activities, 2020









Distribution of custodial sentence length by offence-type in reporting countries, 2020–2023


Percentage of reporting countries that criminalize personal use by region, 2020
