

Prevention and Treatment System

Local presence and accessibility

 Across the country, especially in vulnerable neighborhoods
community legitimacy high



Networking efforts

Coordination with health sectors: national, provincial, and municipal.
Comprehensive and interagency approach.



Social and labor inclusion

- Formation of **50 worker cooperatives**
- With 150 production units



Educational Inclusion

• Coordination and support for individuals' schooling.

Profile of target population

50%: adolescents and young people 12 to 29 years old.

- Percentage of women is higher in outpatient and community-based treatment facilities (CAAC) than in residential ones.
- 47.7%: Incomplete secondary level.
- of these individuals receive assistance to complete education programs.
- **45.6%:** unemployed persons.
- More than 70% of the people served in CAACs did not undergo pretreatments at other care centers.
- An even higher proportion of **women** did not previously access treatment.

LOW-THRESHOLD treatment facility Increased ACCESSIBILITY
