








The Challenge of Drug Abuse



Program Overview


- A dynamic anti-drug mechanism targeting prevention for children of PWUDs.

- Reinforce family and local network support systems.






Data-Driven Needs Assessment

- Needs assessment using local health data, social media, and community feedback.
- Participatory development involving community stakeholders.
- Community Consultation, Interviews and Focus Group Discussions (FGDs) (Qualitative method)
- Surveys and statistical analysis (Quantitative method)



Key Mechanisms Community Engagement and Participatory Development

- Partnerships with Local Government Units (LGUs).
- Involvement of families, law enforcement, CSOs, volunteers, and advocates.
- Collective assessment of children's needs and vulnerabilities.
- Capacity Building for volunteers, partners, and advocates



Key Mechanisms Collaborative Program Implementation

- Development of support system for children of PWUDs.
- Educational and empowerment programs.
- Addressing unique challenges faced by these children.









Social and Emotional Skills

Development

- The objective of this activity is to help children of PWUDs become familiar with the group and fellow beneficiaries.
- This step was also essential to help the facilitator identify each child's strengths and weaknesses.



Spiritual and Moral Enrichment

- Introduce children of PWUDs to the beauty of knowing God
- Broaden understanding of the Bible's significance to families
- Develop awareness and comfort with virtues such as self-respect, respect for others, accountability, and reverence



Behavior Modification

- Allow beneficiaries to share about their family and views on a happy environment
- Encourage open sharing and expression of family experiences
- Helps the program facilitators understand the family story of the children



Physical Development

- Develop physical well-being and positive attitude toward sports and sportsmanship.
- Promote self-discipline through sports
- Prevent involvement in illegal activities



Psychological and Mental Wellness

- Develop awareness among children on managing their thoughts and emotions
- Use of arts, music, and dance
- Psychological status varies based on individual situation and environment; sensitive approach required



Leadership Skills Development

- Develop leadership skills
- Various leadership-building approaches
- Enhance the child's ability to lead and take initiative



Program Monitoring and Accountability

- Establishment of a concrete monitoring system in the barangays
- Creation of accountability tools to track progress and responsibilities



Sustainability and Expansion

- Dynamic approach allows adaptation to different community contexts.
- Scalable strategies for wider implementation.
- Contribution to comprehensive drug abuse prevention literature.
